Elias Polak was born in Amsterdam on the 6th of July, 1899. He was murdered in Mauthausen (Austria) on the 23rd of November, 1942. He worked as mechanic. He was tried for violating Nazi laws, and therefore sent to Mauthausen as part of a special punishment. First, he was deported from the prison in Maastricht to camp Amersfoort, and later to Mauthausen, which was infamous for its especially severe working and living conditions.
