Jenny Kahn-Wesly married Leonard Wesly who was widowed with three sons. From their marriage two daughters were born (both daughters, their husbands and their children were murdered in the Shoah). She worked together with Leonard in a butcher shop on Kesselkade, Maastricht until his death and continued to run the business together with stepson Emile. She must have been an exceptional woman, devoted, caring and upright, as Emile would always say about his stepmother that he hoped his children would love and revere him as much as he did her. She opened her house to the parents of her daughter-in-law when they fled from Germany in 1939. Together with them she was transported to Sobibor where she perished on 11 May 1943.
